The fourth project meeting "Evaluation and Piloting" was held in Chichester, UK from the 11th – 12th of March. The focus was on evaluation of the results from the piloting and making necessary amendments to the materials based on the feedback gathered during and after the piloting process.

During the meeting we also agreed new clear deadlines and discussed the excellent external evaluation feedback from PM3 in Rouen. And all partners gave a presentation of the dissemination actions taken testing materials that will support and help teachers to get involved in the important job of making international mobilities available to all students.



The second day of the meeting we were planning and proposed outline for PM5; Implementation of the project outcomes & a conference open to all interested parties (Turku, Finland November 2015). During the conference the outcomes of the project will be



shared to the attendees. We are planning to have two keynote speakers and different workshops. The 20<sup>th</sup> of April is deadline to agree terms of conference and get ready to promote.

On Thursday evening partners departed for the delights of Historic Portsmouth Harbor to end the meeting with dinner and some shopping.
